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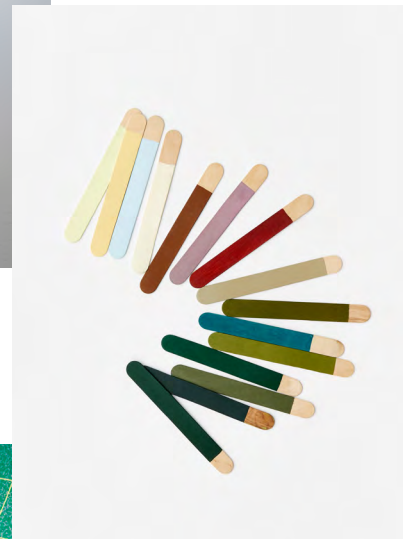


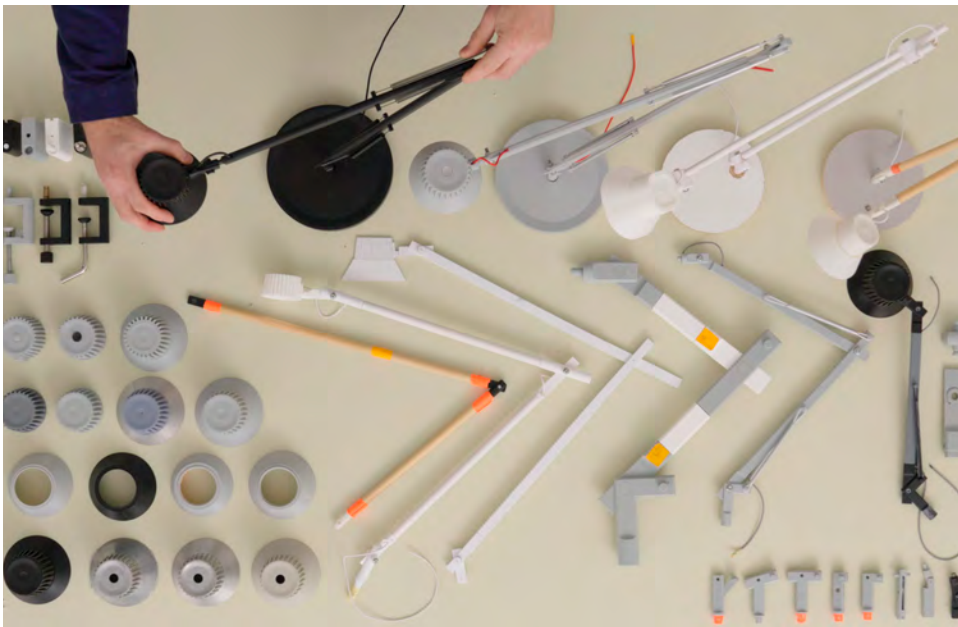

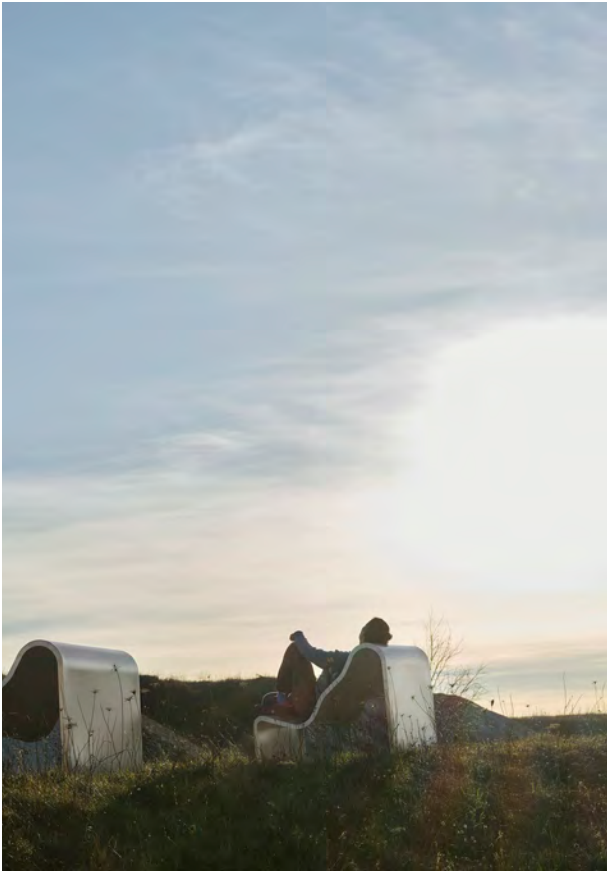

Intuitively, we all know the feeling of entering a room and immediately feeling at ease or stimulated. Interacting with elements of design—whether it's sensations of light, color, or texture—can trigger emotions and spark a dynamic interplay of neurotransmitters in our brains.

Studies have shown that engaging with art, whether through viewing paintings, listening to music, or experiencing a beautifully designed space, can increase blood flow to the brain by up to 10%, equivalent to looking at someone we love.

While many aesthetic expressions affect our bodies and minds, at Muuto we primarily focus on five elements that have been the subject of extensive research—Color, Form, Tactility, Light, and Nature. This research discipline is known as the study of neuroaesthetics.

These principles provide a scientific framework for what we intuitively know: the colors in your living room, the gentle curve of a chair, the texture of a fabric against your skin, or the soft glow of a lamp all influence how you feel.



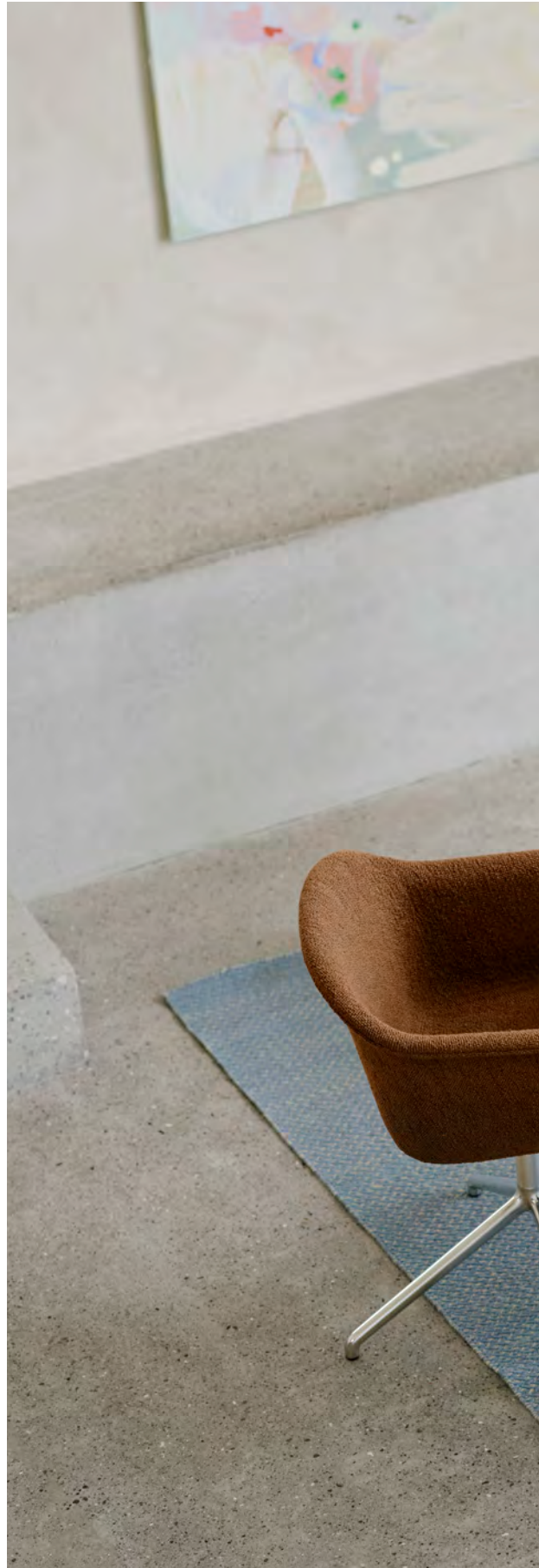

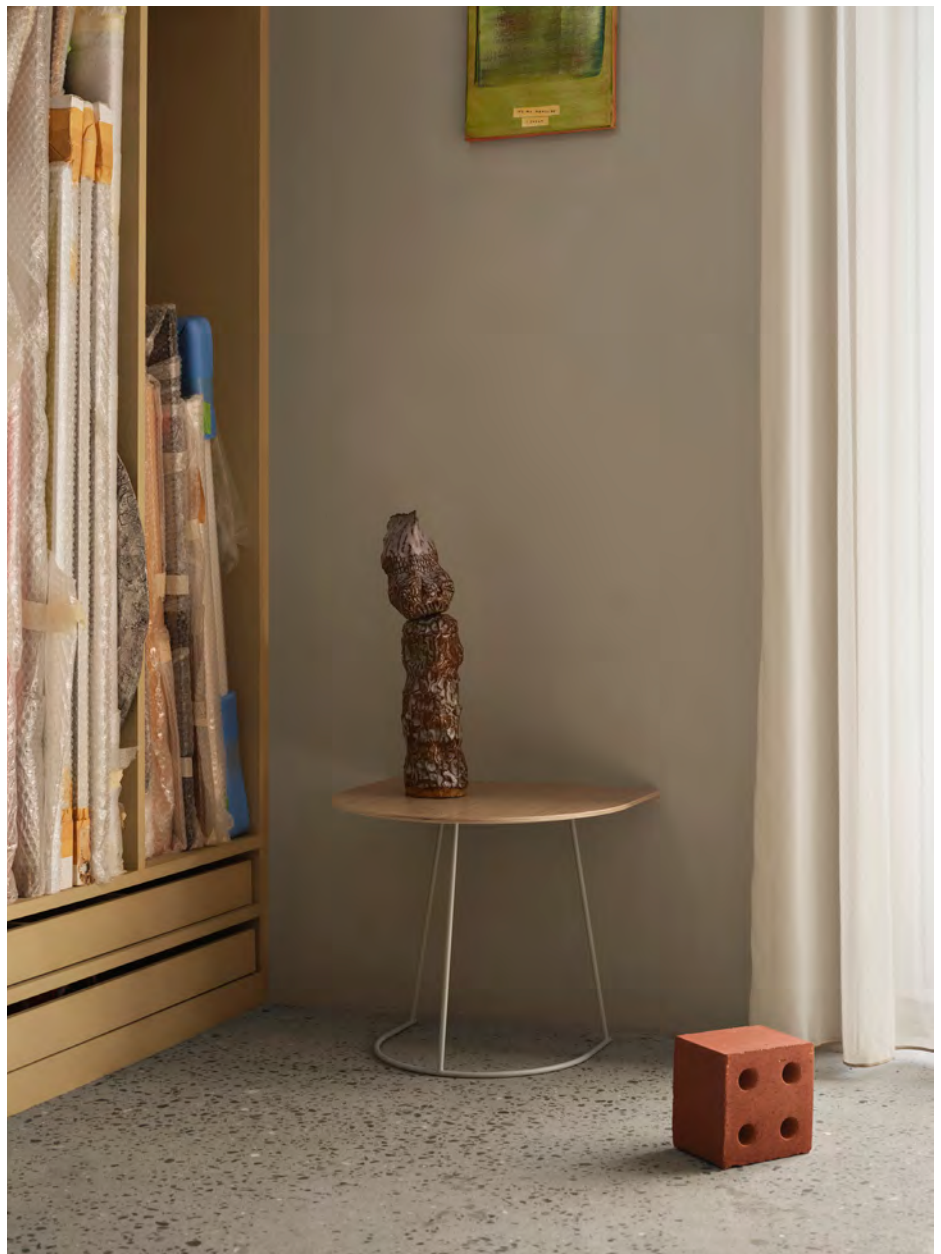

INSIDE WITH—
Wai Tsui



Wai Tsui is the founder of Hiking Patrol, a digital hub at the intersection of fashion, design, and outdoor exploration. He lives just outside Oslo, Norway, with his partner, Adeline, and their son Lian, in a 1970s teak-paneled home that backs onto the forest. Inside Wai's home, the interior is eclectic, thoughtful, and lived-in.

The world outdoors is important for Wai Tsui, the founder of Hiking Patrol. So, two years ago, when he, his partner Adeline Hermier, and their baby son Lian were looking for a new home, they were immediately drawn to a modernist concrete house a stone's throw from Oslo, Norway. From its open terrace, large windows, and garden backing onto the forest, the Norwegian creative can go running in the mountains, take his son sledding in the snow, or simply sit around the fire playing with Lego in the central living space. It's a happy intersection of indoors and outdoors.

His love of the outdoors is a value Wai shares with the creative community he has built through

Hiking Patrol, the digital space he founded back in 2017. A few years on, technically superior garments and design objects made to facilitate a life lived outside remain in high demand.

Tell me about the house you live in.

It's an old concrete house from 1970, that I bought two years ago. We kept the old teak panels and these white stone brick walls. We even kept the bathroom, with its orange and brown colorway. We added concrete floors. There are still a lot of things we want to do to the house, but we will keep it mostly as it is. I enjoy living here. It's my creative space, for sure.

How do you choose the pieces you live with?

I like Japanese and mid-century design; you can see the personalities of Adeline and I in our interior. I try to purchase products that last, so they can move from home to home. Most of this furniture has been with me for almost ten years. Adeline makes ceramics, so we have a lot of her ceramics at home. Sometimes they will be here for a few weeks, then they’ll sell, and we’ll have a new one. We combine light interiors with wooden panels, but we have a steel kitchen as well, so we break up the hard feeling with warmth and light. Because I spend so much time every day here, it’s almost like my playground for inspiration. If I get creative block because I’m spending too much time online, I go to the shelf and take out an old magazine or go for a walk. I’m always trying to curate the things we have, because you come to a point where you don’t need more stuff. I’m trying to be more selective, to create emotional memories with the stuff we already have.

You live with one foot in the city,
one in the countryside.

The first thing that caught our attention about this house was actually the backyard. I can see the forest from our terrace. During the summer we have deers coming into the backyard in the

morning, eating the grass—and there’s a small mountain close by where I can go running. I travel a lot. I go to London to work for three days every month, and then I go to Japan twice a year. But I like to be at home. It’s really quiet in Oslo, so it’s not as stressful an environment here.

Tell me about the role the outdoor world plays in your day-to-day life here.

I am outside every day. I always take my kid to kindergarten, and after that, I go work out. It’s a little bit slippery in the wintertime with the snow, so I normally train in the gym, but I love to run every day when I can. It’s nice because it’s so close to me, I don’t have anything holding me back. That’s been important for me because I work in some stressful environments.

How did Hiking Patrol come about?

I started Hiking Patrol in 2017 as a curation account for outdoor lifestyle exploration, but I just did it for me and my friends. Then we started to work more like a creative agency, collaborating with brands, doing some campaigns and shoots. Over the past couple of years, we’ve started to work on product collaborations too, at the intersection of lifestyle and fashion. As well as clothing and footwear. I work with furniture. I love interior design.

So, I’m trying to create this universe, working on projects that I am passionate about. Everything happens very organically.

Do you have any weekend rituals?

We are mostly together, all three of us, and on Saturdays and Sundays we spend most of our time in the living area in the middle of the house. We play with Lego, do puzzles, play with Play-Doh, try not to watch too much television. Everyone sits on these floor pillows, and my girlfriend always makes Norwegian waffles with brown cheese and jam. Then when we put Lian to bed, we have our moment in the living room. So, we spend most of the time downstairs. I normally also come down to work here, rather than staying in the office, because I like to be in this space.

What does home mean to you?

Home is love. Warmth, gathering, creating memories. We have a lot of family happenings here. It’s a space of creativity. Home for me is also a place where I feel secure, but also where I learn about myself, because I spend a lot of time here. Working freelance, I have time to reflect on things—how I can be better as a human, or how I can strive to be better, evolve, and educate myself. The journey starts in the home. □

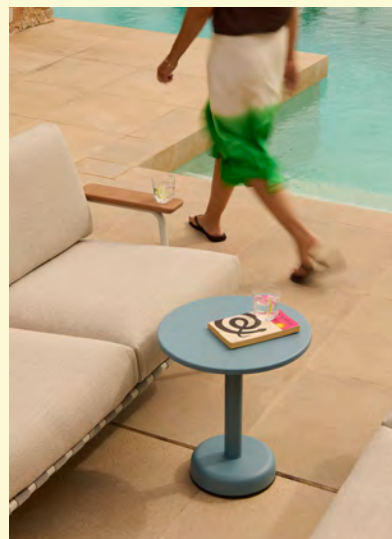

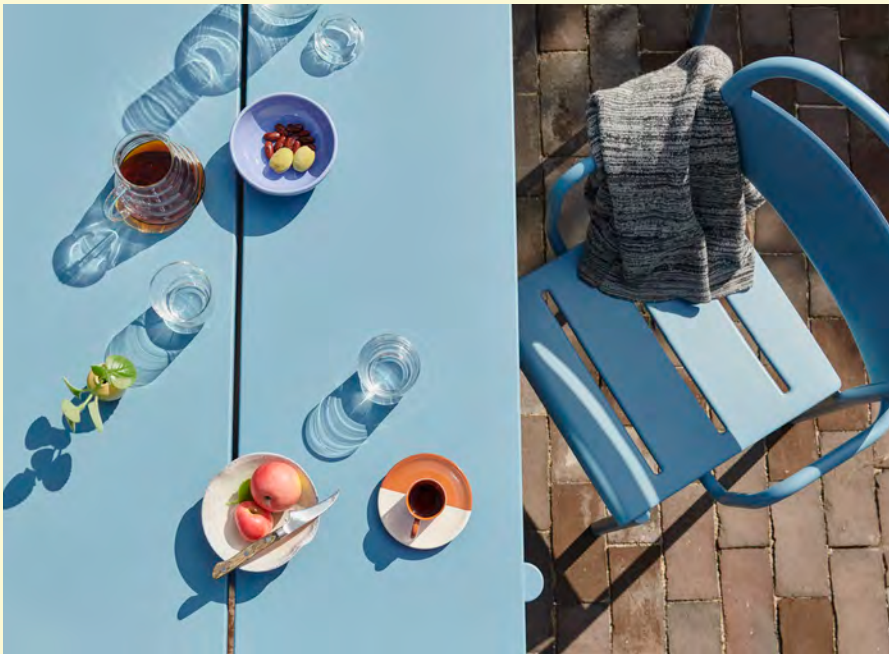

INSIDE WITH—
*Giselle Go &
Philippe Terrien*

Giselle Go and Philippe Terrien's lives move to the rhythm of nature. After years in bustling Tokyo, they sought balance and found it in Misaki, a peaceful fishing village nearby. They discovered a small house with a lush garden and views of the Pacific Ocean and Mount Fuji. Now, they split their time between their Tokyo apartment and the tranquility of their Misaki home, reconnecting with nature along the coastline.



Giselle and Philippe first met in Singapore, introduced by mutual friends while working in fashion. The connection was instant, and within a year, Giselle moved to Tokyo, Philippe's longtime home. Their fast-paced lives were interspersed with countryside getaways, where they fell in love with Japan's landscape and artisanship. This appreciation for Japan is the essence of DAMDAM—their clean skincare brand that showcases Japanese heritage values and ingredients such

as shiso, snow mushrooms, and rice. In Misaki, their weekend home is spacious and lived-in. Fishing baskets sit alongside a growing collection of washi paper, framing the landscape that pours in through the floor-to-ceiling windows. Here, Philippe spends hours in the kitchen, crafting meals from garden-grown herbs and spices, while Giselle finds solace in long, restorative baths with ocean views. "It's magical—this house is our dream place," says Giselle.



How is living in Tokyo?

The magic of Tokyo is the many secrets of the city. When people talk about it, they usually talk about the big attractions like the Sensoji Temple—which is beautiful—but the city has a lot of layers, and you can go very deep into it. There are so many streets with unknown magic places to discover. Now we know the different areas to go for ceramics or vintage shops, but we are always on the quest to discover small places no one talks about. It feeds into our creativity—the constant re-discovery of the city.

You live with one foot in the city and one in nature in your home in Misaki.

When we first met, we would go to the countryside almost every weekend to unwind. We went to discover different places closer to nature and the land, and it came to the point where it made sense to have a home outside Tokyo. We were living in the middle of the city and felt a need to balance it. We had been looking for over two years, and then a friend of ours introduced us to this house by the seaside. It was in bad condition, but we could see that the bones were very good. So we decided to knock it all down and rebuild it.

Can you walk me through the house?

The house was originally built in the 70s by an American photojournalist who moved to Japan. He was interested in a mix of mid-century modern and Japanese design. We tried to preserve the feel of the original house but modernize it at the same time. We left a lot of walls with their original wood, which was preserved

and cleaned, but added window panels all over the house. It was really important for us to have that open feeling of fresh air and light coming inside the home. Now it looks like the ceiling is floating at night because you don't see the wall's glass corners anymore. It's magical—this house is our dream place. We didn't think it would become that.

What is the role of nature in your lives?

Nature is everything. Our alarm clock is the birds. Living so close to nature has been a humbling experience because we had to learn to be attuned to it and its flow. The more you live in nature, the more you understand how it works. We can understand the month of the year depending on which flowers are beginning to grow. Nature is marking the passage of our time.

How do you choose the pieces that you live with?

It is a mix of what we already had and things that were in the original house. We have restored a lot of it. For example, Philippe had a table by David Chipperfield—an old friend—which was a little bit rotten, so we worked with woodworkers in Japan to have a completely new top. We also have things we collected from traveling and a few pieces that were in the house that we just cleaned up and salvaged.

Do you have any rituals?

We grow sage in the garden. We burn it to cleanse the house as well as incense to clear the energies. Otherwise, we normally wake up quite early and have a cup of matcha—we have

been producing our own matcha with an organic farmer from Kyoto. After that, we spend a couple of hours in the garden, especially in summer. Then we have lunch and return for a couple of hours in the evening for gardening.

Where do you go to relax?

We designed two main spaces in the house. For Philippe, the kitchen, and for me, the bathroom. Philippe has a full kitchen to do everything he wants. He works with spices and herbs from the garden, preserves a lot of food, makes bread from scratch, and tries new things—so the kitchen is his area. Mine is the bathroom, which is my sanctuary. I have a wall of windows towards the bamboo garden and a view of the ocean from the Japanese bath. I'm always there.

What is your favorite time of the day in the house?

Philippe: I like it when I wake up. I open the bedroom door and discover the color of the sea of the day. Sometimes, it is completely white because of the waves raging onto the rocks. Sometimes turquoise, sometimes gray or black. You never know what you're going to get. I love that.

Giselle: for me, it's the sunset because it's also different depending on the day. Our neighbors taught me to look at sunsets. I'm learning to observe them and how the sun sets in different locations depending on the season. From here, we see Mount Fuji, and there is one day a year when the sunset is right behind the Mount—called Golden Fuji. That particular day, everyone is excited—it's just perfection. □
